Pets:

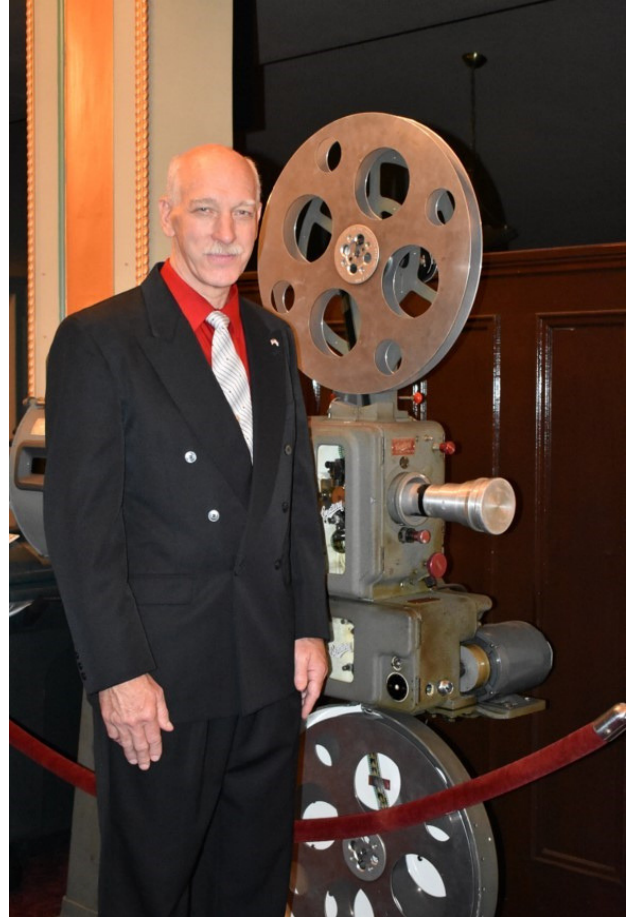
Susan's Chihuahua, Ginger
