UNITED WAY PURSE PROJECT: COLLECTING ITEMS

The Massillon Lions will be participating in the United Way's Purse Project.

The goal of the project is to give love and support to women seeking safety and shelter in the Massillon area by delivering purses filled with personal care items to local shelters. The women they will reach are affected by homelessness, domestic abuse, and substance misuse.

The Massillon Lions will be responsible for collecting travel-sized toothpaste and toothbrushes to fill at least 200 purses for women in the Massillon area.

If you will be reorganizing your home as part of your New Year's resolutions, please also be on the lookout for medium to large purses to donate to the project as well. So as you "Marie Kondo" your closet and find that some purses no longer "bring you joy," consider letting it give another woman joy!

An assembly event will be held on Wednesday, February 12th from 5-7 p.m. at the Massillon Museum, where women from local organizations will assemble the purses and write personal notes to the future recipients of the purses. All purse kits will be distributed to organizations assisting women in Massillon, following the event.
