








Global Pandemic



On that basis, the city activated its Emergency Operations Plan in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5502 and Ohio Administrative Code Section 4501 Incident Command System (ICS)
- Currently, the city is operating under the National Incident Management System (NIMS) under a Unified Command with Terri Argent as the lead IC and Chief Moser and Chief Burgasser, additional Incident Commanders. The City currently operates by way of an Incident Action Plan (IAP) with weekly/biweekly meetings. The current IAP is on our website and updated regularly during the operational periods (every 2 weeks)




- All City personnel faced many serious challenges for the health and safety of city employees, and city residents, during this global pandemic

Sidewalk Repair Assistance
