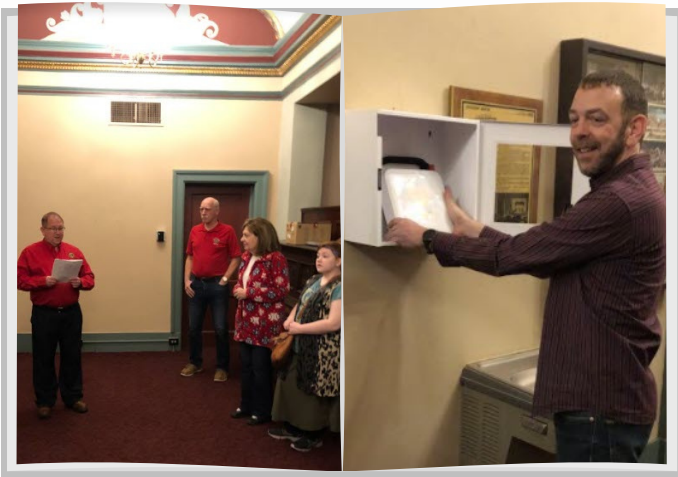

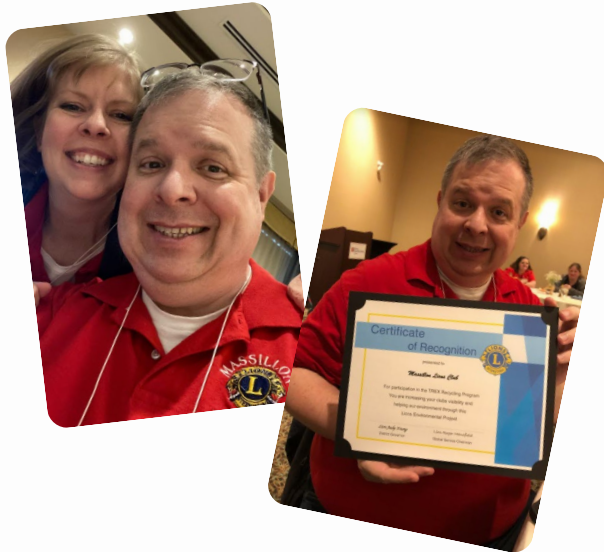
So far, we've had a great year! Let's have a great fourth quarter and finish off the Year.
