Chartered in 1943, the Massillon Lions Club is known for its efforts in sight and hearing conservation and community service.

The Club pays for eyeglasses and exams, hearing aids, and batteries for those in need.

In 1981 the Club purchased the Lincoln Theatre to preserve a local historical landmark, to provide public service by offering entertainment at reasonable prices, and to offer a public meeting space in the upstairs meeting room.

The Massillon Lions continue to care for the Lions Lincoln Theatre by serving on the Theatre Board of Trustees, assisting with fundraising, and staffing volunteer positions.
